- Responsible for:** Planning, implementation and execution of Urban Plunge initiative for students in grades during the summer of 2007. Responsibility includes the utmost care of the host facility and student supervision and safety.

- Two years of college or university experience.
 - Experience leading mission trips/group experiences with adults and teens.
 - First Aid and CPR certification is suggested.
 - Related ministry experience in local or campus ministry.
- Additional Responsibilities and Expectations**
- Host groups during their time in downtown Dayton.
 - Coordinate daily service activities and see students' lives change as they experience Christ through service.
 - Facilitating each group's schedule and lead evening discussions/debriefs to help them process their experiences.
 - Maintain the overall spiritual focus of the Urban Plunge effort.
 - Orient students to the city and Urban Plunge rules and guidelines.
 - This person will be expected to live in the downtown housing location for the duration of each week's mission trip
 - Forge meaningful and long-lasting relationships with social service agencies and other ministry opportunities within downtown Dayton.
 - Frame each ministry site and activity as a service focus and Christ modeling activity.
 - Enforce student/adult ratios of 7 to 1 at all times. Enforce Ginghamsburg Safety Policy and discipline at all times.
 - Provide leadership to participants by participating in service projects when appropriate.
 - Get to know the various needs of the urban Dayton area and realize how service opportunities can make a difference.
 - Help students see the reasons behind why they serve
