CHOOSE FROM **FOUR** LEVELS OF MISSION TRIPS:

- 1 PROJECT NEIGHBORHOOD:** These are one-day service opportunities focused on our Fort McKinley Campus neighborhood--great opportunities to get your feet wet and serve on mission while never leaving the Dayton area.
- 2 MINISTRY BLITZ:** a short-term mission trip lasting anywhere from two to five days and requiring an overnight stay on location. If you can't commit a whole week or longer for a mission trip, a Blitz may be just for you!
- 3 MISSION TREK:** a mission trip lasting about a week. These trips take you within the United States as well as to foreign countries and are designed for those who are ready to take the next big step in service. If you feel called to put in a week of hard work and be a part of a missions team that will impact a community, a Mission Trek is a journey you need to experience.
- 4 GLOBAL EXPEDITION:** Most Global Expedition trips are 7 to 14 days in length and involve travel overseas. These expeditions are higher level trips that provide the opportunity to immerse yourself for a longer period in the targeted community and culture. If you're ready for an advanced challenge, a Global Expedition with Ginghamburg may be just right.

MINISTRY BLITZ TRIPS

**BROKEN CHAINS MOTORCYCLE MISSION - JOHNSTOWN, PA
"THUNDER IN THE VALLEY" MOTORCYCLE RALLY**

June 22-27

Grab your bike and join the motorcycle mission team to Johnstown, Pennsylvania. Ginghamsburg's Broken Chains Motorcyclists will travel together, on their motorcycles, to the 14th annual "Thunder in The Valley" rally to reach out to tens of thousands of people in the biker community. This trip is a great opportunity for bikers to go on mission with their bike to reach out to other bikers by building relationships, serving and doing "random acts of kindness." In addition, there will be planned opportunities to partner with community organizations and local churches to provide help for those in need. Don't have a motorcycle? Then join the support team and travel in the Broken Chains support vehicle. Bikers, join the **SERVOLUTION at the Thunder In The Valley Motorcycle rally!**

Attendance at a Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meeting is required. The pre-trip meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of departure.

Lodging/Food: Motel accommodations (2 persons/room), restaurant food

Who: Adults who have a heart to minister to the "biker" community

Cost: \$325 (includes shared fuel cost for the support team vehicle, 1 meal per day, motel lodging, t-shirt and ministry costs) The total cost is \$585 per person if you do not share a hotel room.

BROKEN CHAINS MOTORCYCLE MISSION - IRONTON, OH “IRONTON RALLY ON THE RIVER” MOTORCYCLE RALLY

August 18-21

Grab your bike and join the motorcycle mission team to Ironton, Ohio. Ginghamburg’s Broken Chains Motorcyclists will travel together, on their motorcycles, to the 8th annual “Ironton Rally on the River” rally to reach out to thousands of people in the biker community. This trip is a great opportunity for bikers to go on mission with their bike to reach out to other bikers by building relationships, serving and doing “random acts of kindness.” In addition, there will be planned opportunities to partner with community organizations and local churches to provide help for those in need. Don’t have a motorcycle? Then join the support team and travel in the Broken Chains support vehicle. Bikers, join the **SERVOLUTION** at the Ironton Rally on the River!

Attendance at a Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meeting is required. The pre-trip meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of departure.

Lodging/Food: Team will stay at a church and sleep on air mats, restaurant food

Who: Adults who have a heart to minister to the “biker” community

Cost: \$75 (includes shared fuel cost for the support team vehicle, lodging, t-shirt and some ministry costs)

NEW YORK CITY

November 17-21

Travel by van to the City that Never Sleeps to further engage in the Ginghamburg **SERVOLUTION**. The team will not build any structures on this trip but instead will go to help build and repair people's spirits and souls. Imagine setting up a "prayer table" in Grand Central Station offering to pray for the commuters. (Previous teams have had people lined up waiting for prayer.) Other opportunities included on this trip: serving meals, non-offensive street evangelism, Bible distribution, plus more. This team will be able to spend time seeing the sights and experiencing much of what NYC has to offer. Join the **SERVOLUTION** as we take a bite out of the "Big Apple"!

Attendance at a Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meeting is required. The pre-trip meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of departure. Team members are also urged to take an optional evangelism training class offered through Ginghamburg's adult discipleship program—schedule to be announced.

Lodging/Food: Local church's dorm-style accommodations and restaurant food

Who: Adults

Cost: \$399 (includes travel expenses, lodging, meals, Metro Card and sightseeing)

Registration: November 1; final payment due the week of the trip

- Each team member will be responsible for meals in transit
- Each team member will be responsible for bringing additional spending money (suggested \$50-\$100)

CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

December 1-4

Travel by van and leave Thursday afternoon for the Windy City. This team will stay in the International Youth Hostel at night and spend their days engaging in a variety of mission opportunities. One morning you will weatherize homes for the elderly, and then you will host a Christmas party for homeless women at a shelter. At night you will serve in a soup kitchen at men's and women's late night shelters, and that is all in one day. On another day you will have the opportunity to serve behind the scenes at the Willow Creek Care Center and prepare food for distribution to the poor. In the afternoon you will go to the famous Chicago Food Depository and serve. That's not all, you will also visit some of the famous sites in Chicago as you spend a night out on the town. The **SERVOLUTION** is headed to Chicago; are you going to join it?

Attendance at a Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meeting is required. The pre-trip meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of departure.

Lodging/Food: Bunk beds in male/female rooms; cafeteria-style food with some meals out

Who: Adults

Cost: \$199 (includes travel by van, some meals and lodging)

In 2005, Ginghamburg started a **SERVOLUTION** with the “Extreme Neighborhood Makeover” movement in New Orleans and has since sent 65 Hurricane Relief Teams to help the victims of Hurricane Katrina through 2010. In 2011 Ginghamburg teams will continue this service revolution by going to help those still suffering and in need. Much remains to be done! Join hundreds of servant missionaries from Ginghamburg to help rebuild homes, restore families and bring the **SERVOLUTION** to the hopeless in New Orleans.

Attendance at a Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meeting is required. The pre-trip meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of your team's departure.

Lodging/Food: Teams will bed down in a local church with mats and cots. Meals will be prepared together by each team.

Who: Adults with construction skills ranging from basic to advanced. No construction skills? We also need those with a simple willingness to serve, cook/prepare meals and handle other tasks.

Cost: \$299 (includes travel by van, meals, lodging, t-shirts and project costs)

Registration and final payment due: One week before the departure of your trip

RED BIRD MISSION BEVERLY, KY

Trip #1: May 22-28

Trip #2: August 21-27

Red Bird Mission is located in the Appalachian Mountains of Southeastern Kentucky, where it empowers individuals and advocates justice by providing educational, health and community outreach ministries to area low-income residents. Joining

this SERVOLUTION will provide you the opportunity to repair homes for low-income community residents and do maintenance for Red Bird Mission buildings and grounds. These projects could include roof replacement, small room additions, painting, building porches or ramps and grounds keeping. Other light duty work is available for those who are not construction able. Join this SERVOLUTION to make a difference in the lives of very needy people who reside right here in the U.S.

Attendance at a Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meeting is required. The pre-trip meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of your team's departure.

Lodging/Food: Teams will sleep in a bunk house on bunk beds, and meals will be provided for the team.

Who: Adults with construction skills ranging from basic to advanced. No construction skills? We also need those with a simple willingness to serve in other areas.

Cost: \$425 (includes travel by van, meals, lodging, t-shirts and project costs)

Registration and final payment due: Two weeks before the departure of your trip

Note: Each team member will be responsible for meals in transit

JAMAICA MISSION

February 19-26

The Ginghamburg **SERVOLUTION** will return to Jamaica in 2011 to serve through medical mission. Our teams will be hosted through the American Caribbean Experience organization. The medical part of this opportunity is primarily for trained medical/healthcare professionals to serve the Jamaican people through a variety of medical services in the clinic setting. Non-medical persons can also be a part of this team by providing valuable assistance to the health care professionals. The service and work project part is for individuals of any skill level to serve through painting, making minor repairs, praying for individuals at the clinics, etc.

This **SERVOLUTION** opportunity will empower you in your walk and transform your life, as God works through you to meet the needs of others - you will never be the same. *Most Jamaica trips will include R&R time daily, as well as possible side trips to local attractions.

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation. Preparation meeting schedules will be established closer to the date of each trip's departure.

Lodging/Food: Local hotel/ local cuisine; cafeteria style food and sack lunches

Who: Adults with skills in any of the following: medical, service and labor

Costs: \$1,375

*All trip costs include airfare, meals, travel insurance and lodging. Depending on the trip other expenses may include medicine for med trips, miscellaneous supplies.

Registration: Due with a \$500 deposit seven weeks before departure; final payment due 10 days prior to departure

HAITI

Trip #1: April 25-May 1

Trip #2: June 18-25

Trip #3: October 29 - November 5

Here is your chance to bring love and hope to the hearts of the people of Haiti through the Ginghamburg **SERVOLUTION**! Haiti is the poorest nation in the western hemisphere

and has spent years mired in the hopelessness left from a long history of slavery, violence, voodoo and profound poverty. In 2008 Haiti was struck with four devastating hurricanes in quick succession. In a period of one month they were pounded by Fay, Gustav, Hanna and Ike. The destruction and aftermath of these hurricanes has created a serious crisis for a people who were already living in desperate circumstances. In 2010 massive earthquakes rocked Haiti and sent the country into even more chaos and turmoil.

On trip #1 and 2 teams will likely fly into Port au Prince and travel to the orphanage at Fedja near Mirebalais. The team will have the option to work with the orphans and deaf children as well as opportunities for medical work in the clinic in Mirebalais. In addition opportunities may be available for Vacation Bible School (VBS) with the children, basketball camps, construction work around the orphanage, food distribution programs and more.

On trip #3, your team will likely fly into Cap Haitien in the north of Haiti and travel to Milot where you will stay in missionary housing with the goal of serving through construction on the GVCM Christian training center that is located there. There may also be opportunities for VBS, food distribution programs, I-Tec vision care and medical aid. Your team will also travel to many different communities and villages that past Ginghamburg teams have served in.

Be part of **SERVOLUTION** to reclaim Haiti and offer hope, love and support to our brothers and sisters as a part of this team. Ginghamburg will partner with the ministry of “M1615M” and GVCM for this trip.

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation on this trip. Preparation meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of the trip's departure.

Lodging/Food: Dormitory style housing with separate sleeping quarters for men and women, cafeteria style food

Who: Adults with all skill levels and a heart for Third World ministry

Cost: \$1499 (includes airfare, travel expenses, lodging, food and ministry)

Registration: A \$500 deposit for trip 1 is due March 1; final payment due April 1.

A \$500 deposit for trip 2 is due April 15; final payment due June 10.

A \$500 deposit for trip 3 is due September 1; final payment due October 15.

COSTA RICA

July 9-17

You and your team will begin your **SERVOLUTION** with a flight to San Jose, Costa Rica. From there you will bus eight hours south to the La Palma Methodist Church in La Palma, Costa Rica on the beautiful Osa Peninsula, which will be your team's work site for the week. Your team's two main tasks will be to continue construction on the only Methodist church on the peninsula as well as construction on a fellowship hall and grounds area. Other activities may include a week-long Bible school for children and help with outreach ministries of the church. This trip is for any skill level, and all adults are welcome. In addition to the missions work, your team will spend one day on the Pacific and possibly tour Poas volcano.

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation on this trip. Preparation meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of the trip's departure.

Lodging/food: local hotel, meals cooked and eaten at the work site

Who: 15-20 adults, all skill levels and a heart to serve and engage cross-culturally

Cost: \$1,199 (includes airfare, travel expenses, lodging, food and ministry)

Registration: A \$500 deposit is due March 15; final payment due April 15

Notes:

- Each team member will be responsible for meals during international transit
- Each team member will be responsible for getting the necessary shots and immunizations required—information at www.cdc.gov

COLUMBIA

Trip #1 January 21-24 - TRIP FULL

Trip #2 July 9-16

Join the **SERVOLUTION** by signing up for the first ever Ginghamburg Mission to Columbia. This trip is an opportunity to join the holistic work already taking place through **UMCOR** by helping in the development of six small villages in a remote area on the northeast coast of Colombia. Your trip will provide opportunities for construction, spiritual development, and health and medical service opportunities. Help Ginghamburg as we pioneer a **SERVOLUTION** in Columbia!

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation on this trip. Preparation meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of the trip's departure.

Lodging/Food: Hotel style lodging, restaurant style meals

Who: All adults of any skill level are encouraged to participate on this team, including those who are construction types, hard workers, medical professionals and medical students, and those with a heart for Third World ministry.

Cost: \$1299 (includes round trip airfare to Columbia, meals, lodging, transportation and some ministry expenses)

Registration: A \$500 deposit for trip two by June 1; final payment due July 1

GHANA, WEST AFRICA

October 21-29

Journey to a village in Ghana, West Africa that is taking a bold step. This village, Noka, is taking the responsibility for working out the solutions to some of its most urgent problems. You will enter the village as a learner and encourager: observing, asking questions, admiring work already done, visiting and praying in homes throughout the village, sharing your spiritual story and offering whatever specific skills you possess. Join the SERVOLUTION in Ghana by helping with this community transformation movement underway in the village of Noka. Not only will you witness the power of change in a small African community, but your life will be deeply impacted.

***Upon receipt of your application, an interview will be scheduled to discuss your role on the team.**

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation on this trip. Preparation meeting schedule will be established closer to the date of the trip's departure. (As mentioned above due to the nature of this trip, applicants may be interviewed prior to trip to determine participation and acceptance.)

Lodging/Food: Hotel style lodging, restaurant or cafeteria style meals (American food)

Who: Adults of all skill levels, those with a heart for Africa, church planting and Third World ministry

Cost: \$2499 (includes round trip airfare to Ghana, entry visas, meals, lodging, transportation and some ministry expenses)

Registration: A \$500 deposit is due August 15; final payment due October 1

- Each team member will be responsible for meals during international transit**

A non-refundable \$50 registration fee is due with your registration. This fee is applied to the balance of the trip cost. All adults registering for certain trips may be subject to an interview process for acceptance.

Please make note of final registration and deposit deadlines for your trip, listed with each trip description. The deposit can be paid prior to the due date but becomes non-refundable after the designated deadline listed. Your deposit goes toward securing your spot on the trip and is applied toward the balance of the trip cost. Places on each trip are filled “first come, first served,” so turn in your deposit and registration as soon as possible.

When your registration and deposit are received, you will receive ongoing updates about trip developments, mandatory pre-trip training classes and information concerning your next steps in preparation to go on mission. You will be expected to attend all of the required pre-trip training/preparation meetings unique to your particular mission trip.
