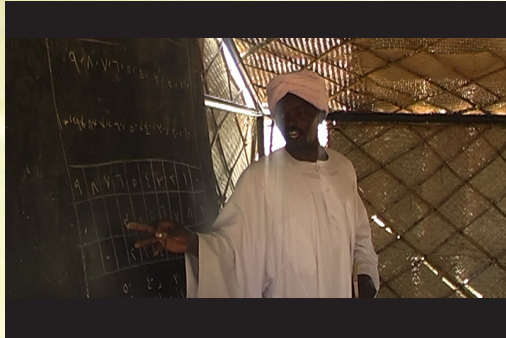

otherwise be lost forever.

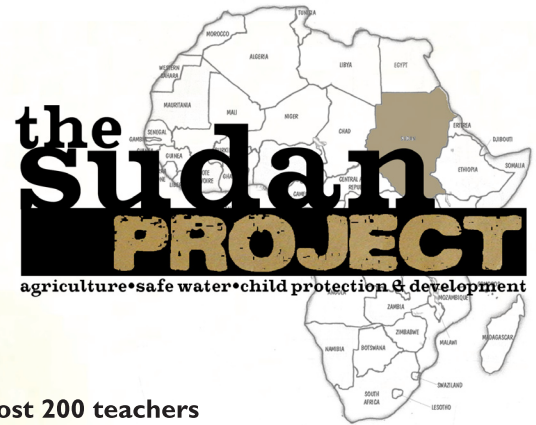


**26,000 people, 5208 families,**
