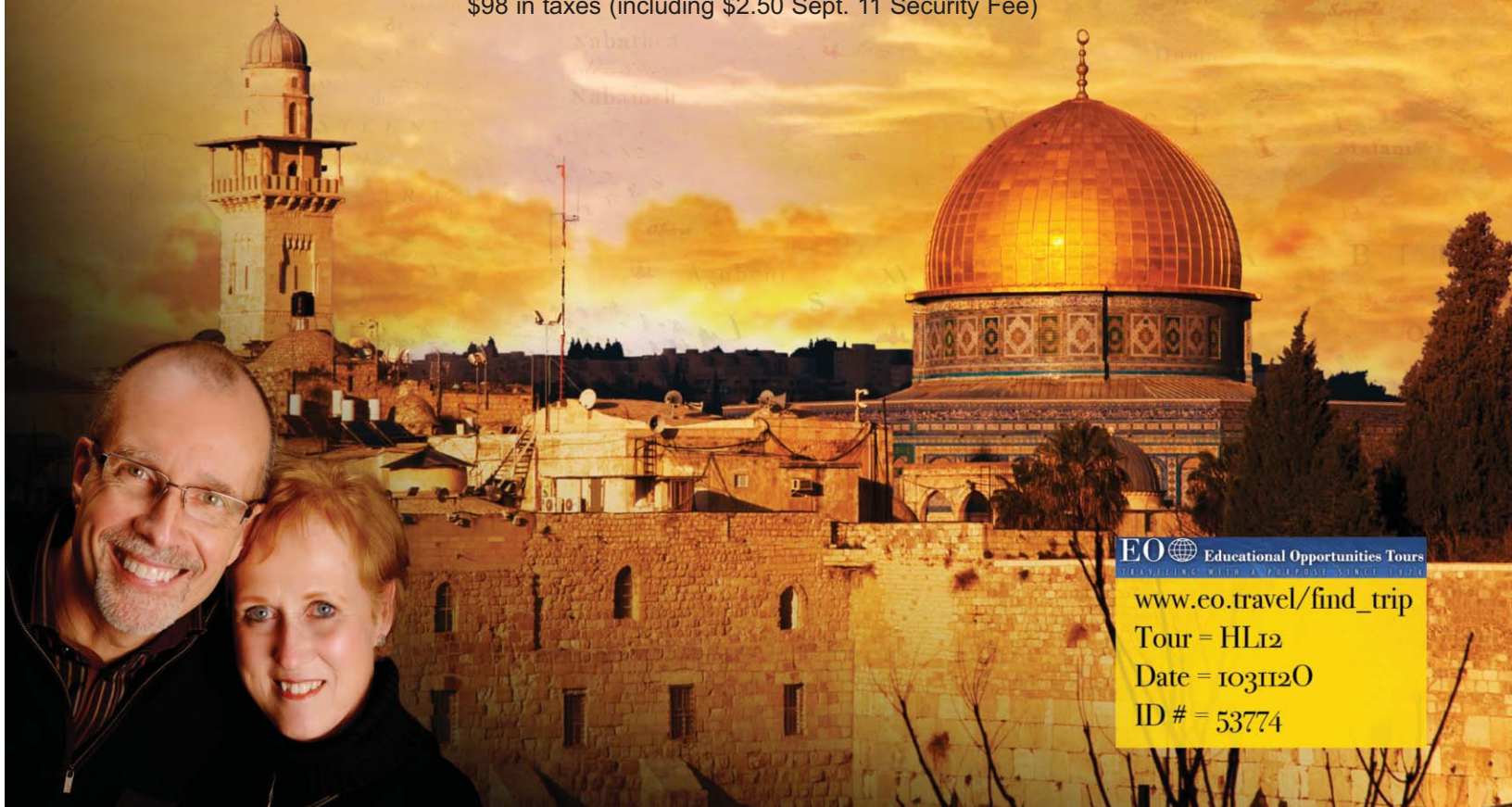

Holy Land Classic 2012

31 Oct W - Day 1 – Depart USA

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight.

01 Nov H - Day 2 - USA to the Holy Land

You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy dinner before you rest.

02 Nov F Day 3 - The Galilee

With Bible in hand, cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee aboard a Kinnereth Sailing Company boat. Along the way, participate in a special on board worship service. Travel to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. Visit the synagogue which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matthew 4). At Kibbutz Nof Ginosar, you'll learn about the "Ancient Boat", a rare example of the kind of boat in which Jesus would have sailed. Travel to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached to the people (Matthew 5-7). At Tabgha, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the Church of the Fish and the Loaves (Luke 9). You'll also stop at the shore of the Sea of Galilee at the Chapel of the Primacy. Here Peter three times professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). At the River Jordan you can remember your baptism in the Yardenit Baptismal Site.

03 Nov S - Day 4 – Northern Israel

Begin your morning on the slopes of Mount Hermon from Nimrod's Castle. This Muslim and Crusader fortress was named for the biblical Nimrod (Genesis 8). At nearby Tel Dan, see the mud brick arch constructed in pre-Israelite (Canaanites) times and where The House of David fragment-from the First Temple Period-was discovered. Visit Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus traveled with His disciples and where nearby Peter made his great confession to Jesus, "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matt. 16: 16). Enjoy lunch in a Druze village. Look out toward Damascus from Mount Bental. Travel on through the strategic tableland known as the Golan Heights. Return to your hotel for your last night in the Galilee.

04 Nov U - Day 5 – Caesarea, Megiddo, Nazareth, Beit Shean, Dead Sea

Depart the Galilee to visit the Roman Aqueduct and Theatre at Caesarea, a center of the early Christians. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new religion (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for Trial. Travel the ancient caravan route to Tel Megiddo where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Visit Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2). Explore the Nazareth Village, a living presentation of the life, times, and teachings of Jesus of Nazareth. Visit the ruins of Beit Shean which was continuously inhabited for 5000 years and was one of the Roman cities Jesus passed on his way from Galilee to Jerusalem. Drive through the Jordan River Valley to the Dead Sea for dinner and overnight.

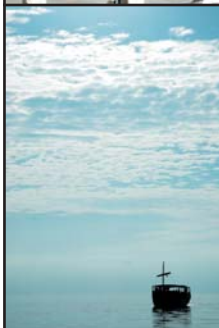
05 Nov M - Day 6 – Masada, Jericho, Qumran, and Bethlehem

This morning we'll journey to Masada, Herod's mountaintop fortress which became the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Travel to Jericho and visit the ruins of the ancient city, which was conquered by Joshua (Joshua 6). From Jericho, you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matthew 4). Travel to Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Even today, the road from the Dead Sea to Jerusalem twists for miles as it climbs from below sea level into the Judean Mountains. Jesus traveled the nearby Roman road, the setting of His parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10). Finish your day in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

06 Nov T – Day 7 - Bethlehem

This morning, you'll visit the cave revered as the place where Jesus was born (Matthew 1; Luke 2). The church, which was constructed on the site, is the world's oldest functioning church. Nearby you'll view Shepherds' Field where the

Good News was first heard. This afternoon visit the Bethlehem Arab society for Rehabilitation and interact with local Arabs here. This evening, meet with a local Christian community to fellowship and understand their present status.

07 Nov W - Day 8 - Jerusalem

Cross over from Bethlehem to Jerusalem. View the Kidron Valley and the Valley of Gehenna as we stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1). Pray in the Garden of Gethsemane as Jesus prayed (Matthew 26). Continue to Mount Zion to visit the House of the High Priest Caiaphas where Jesus was imprisoned for a night (Matthew 26). Stand in the Upper Room, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14). Meet with local Christian or Muslim leaders

08 Nov H - Day 9 - Jerusalem and the Old City

Conditions permitting; walk the Temple Mount, home to the Dome of the Rock and Al-Asqa mosque. Visit the Southern Wall Excavations of the ancient Temple, including the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. Walk the Cardo, the ancient main street of the Old City. Once lined with shops it is now partially restored. View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle, and sing a hymn in the acoustically beautiful Church of St. Anne. Visit Herod's Antonia Fortress where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23). Walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross," and stand in reverence at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

09 Nov F - Day 10 - Jerusalem On Own

Today is yours to explore and shop in Jerusalem. Some may choose to go to Yad Vashem, and experience the Holocaust Museum. Others may wish to visit the Israel museum with the Shrine of the Book and First Century Model. Walk to the Old City to revisit a site or to shop in the Arab Souk (market) or in the Jewish Quarter.

10 Nov S - Day 11 - Jerusalem

Travel to Emmaus, where Jesus, after His resurrection, walked with two of his disciples who did not recognize Him until He later broke bread with them in their home (Luke 24:13-35). Visit and worship at the Garden Tomb, possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea and experience the reality of the Resurrection. Enjoy time on your own to explore the Old City until time to prepare for your return flight.

11 Nov U - Day 12 - Return to USA

Return home with memories of the people and places of the Holy Land!
