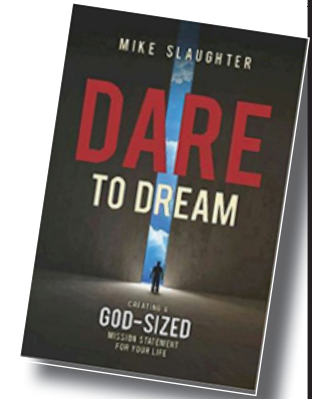
HAPPY FATHER'S DAY, Dads!
